Example Projects

Keesler Air Force Base, Mississippi

Following Hurricane Katrina, Keesler Air Force Base in Biloxi, Mississippi was inundated with up to 6 feet of salt water. About 3,000 trees and tens of thousand of plants were destroyed.

EQM restored landscaping along the base's main roads, entry gates, parade grounds, recreational areas, and high-profile buildings. EQM was awarded a follow-on contract to restore landscaping around the medical center and to plant an additional 1,500 trees base-wide.

U.S. Air Force Academy, Colorado

EQM provided landscape restoration services to the U.S. Air Force Academy in Colorado following the completion of several construction projects. The work included reseeding and revegetation.

Lake Geneva, Wisconsin

EQM remediated a former trap and skeet shooting range built on the site of a wetland in Lake Geneva Wisconsin. The 20-acre wetland was drained, contaminated seeds were removed, and the entire wetland area was reconstructed. EQM also constructed fish and waterfowl enclosures and performed short and long-term maintenance that included annual burns and mowing.

Ruddiman Creek, Michigan

Ruddiman Creek and Ruddiman Pond in Muskegon, Michigan was a chemical dumping ground for chemical wastes from local industry.

EQM conducted a post-sediment dredging and cleanup restoration project involving about 230,000 square feet of disturbed ground, including a creek, pond, and erosion control devices.
